Additionally, the catalogue features educational materials created by teachers who led Blue Projects funded by ProBleu's grant calls, fostering a collaborative tool for educators worldwide.

This catalogue supports our wider aim for schools to join the **European Blue Schools Network**, a community of educators and students dedicated to sustainable practices and marine and freshwater protection. The ProBleu initiative aligns closely with the **EU Mission: Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030**, engaging school communities in impactful educational activities that nurture a culture of responsibility for protecting our ocean and freshwater resources.
